1. Operations & Use

 \Rightarrow Receive a call:

Pick-up the handset when the phone rings. Put the handset back in the cradle when call is finished.

⇒ Dial:

Pick-up the handset, you will hear a dialing tone - dial the number.

 \Rightarrow Store numbers:

Pick-up the handset, press STORE key and input the numbers, press STORE key again and press any key of 0-9 as address of your stored number. Put the handset back in the cradle.


 \Rightarrow Speed dialing
